

Your induction

We want to ensure you have a warm welcome to Imperial College Healthcare NHS Trust. To help with this we have put together an induction programme which will introduce you to the Trust and also your department and role, this includes the corporate welcome programme and your local induction, and guidance on transferring mandatory learning to us from another NHS organisation.

Everyone

- **Mandatory learning training topics:** these are related to patient and staff safety and are mandatory for everyone working here. - **Local Induction:** You should complete a local induction with your manager once you start work in your department. This will introduce you to your job and department/team, plus local arrangements which are important to your role.

Healthcare Support Workers (including maternity support workers and rehab assistants)
